 active partnership between patients organizations, healthcare professionals
 and pharmaceutical or biotech companies with an interest in EB.
- Commit to improve the collaboration between DEBRA International, pharmaceutical companies and biotech companies on the international level, to optimize healthcare and equal access to treatments for all persons with EB.
- Respects other members of DIRC and has a desire to be present at every meeting.
